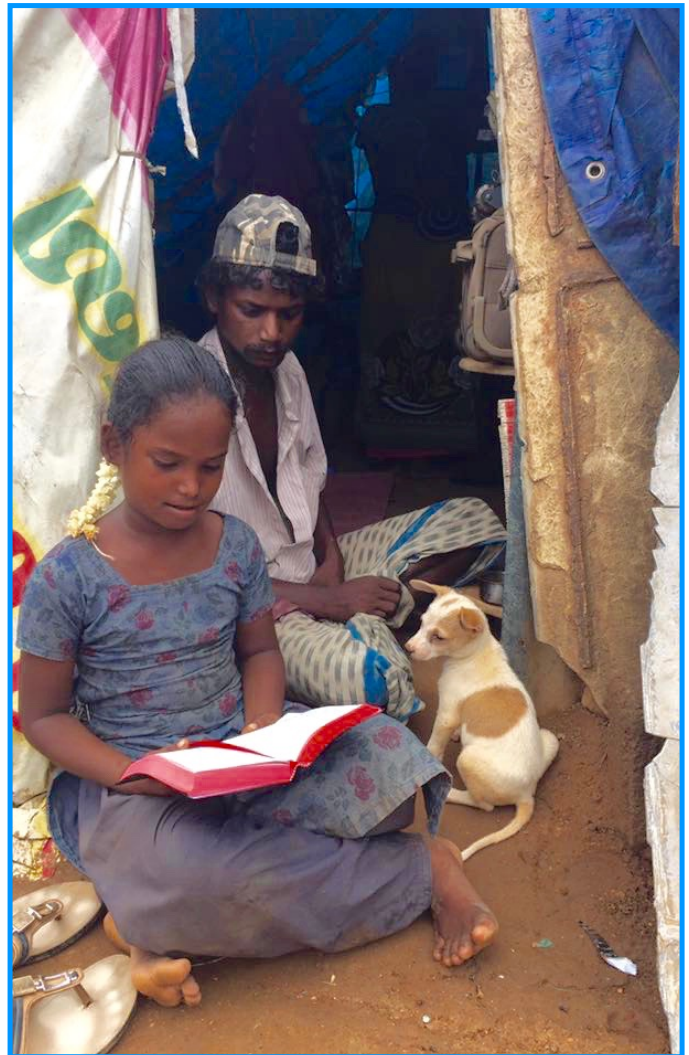

I am in 7th grade, I like my school and I thank you for supporting me to go to school. I have a good father, but he is an alcoholic and has been drinking every day since my mother got killed by an explosion at the quarry where she was working ten years ago. In his grief my father started drinking more and more. He is illiterate and he can't read or write. When I attended VBS in a nearby village, they offered that if we would read it every day we would get a Bible for free. I promised that I would, and I got a brand new Bible. Every day I read the Bible out loud, with my father and my dog Juju listening to the reading of God's Book. My father always asks me to read the Bible when he comes back from his work because it's comforting. The more he listened, the less he drank, and today he is completely sober and has no more desire for alcohol. He stopped chewing tobacco, he accepted Jesus and now both of us go to the church where I got the Bible. People in the church love us and help us with everything we need. My father sings Christian songs and memorizes Bible scriptures. I thank you for giving me the Bible that transformed my father's life and gave us a life full of joy and blessings. I will never stop reading the Bible because it has the power of God".



Constructing New Church Buildings In Villages



India is the birthplace of several religions: Hinduism, Buddhism, Jainism, and Sikhism, and home for thousands of years to Jewish, Muslim, Christian and other religions communities. The vast majority of citizens of all religious groups live in peaceful coexistence and are conscious of religious freedom. At times violence is committed by radicals against Christians and many have been killed mostly by fire. Government authorities are demanding the churches to be properly built and safe for public gatherings, if not they will force to close the churches. Our project is to construct 50 new church buildings that will seat 200 people in Northern India for believers to have a safe facility to come together to worship.
