Today 300 children have a safe place

We helped thousands of earthquake survivors in Nepal with basic needs: clothes, blankets, food, water and school supplies. As soon as we arrived, we started building a bamboo structure to serve as a temporary children home. Today 300 children have a safe place to live and grow in a positive environment of love and hope. We are praying for the means to build a permanent structure that can withstand future earth quakes. Our church is continuously helping people in the devastated areas. We need your continued support to help children and their families. Many are still living in the ruins of their homes, and there is no hope for the future. Many of our Christian brothers and sisters are suffering from lack of water or food. Note from Jeremy

Nepal is one of the most dangerous places in the world, not because of the people, but the geography. Nepal is a country full of huge mountains, which means dangerous cliffs and no straight roads. A short distance takes hours to cover. But even though the earthquake has hit hard and destroyed houses and killed approximately 6,200, the people are very happy and friendly. We distributed food and water to the homeless, and school supplies to the children. Our mission was a success.



Children Home in Cambodia

In Cambodia, I ministered to a group of Pastors and Leaders and encouraged them with the Word of God. They are the hope for Cambodia. Christians only make up around 2% of the population, and there are very few missionaries. Child sex exploitation is prevalent, and there are thousands of children living in very dangerous condition. Children are sold as a commodity. Mission in Action is helping 20 orphans, and we working to get permission to build a children home in Cambodia. Please pray for this project to bring hope and future to the children that need desperate help. As a result of abject poverty, desperate parents are forced to sell their children. With no state support, parents unable to work because of illness or disability find their only choice is to send their children to work.



People living in poverty are more vulnerable to accept offers of financial support and assistance in exchange for sex. Poor families sell their own daughters as young as 5 or 6 years old, who are bought and then raped. Some of the children are illegally transported across borders to other countries for child labor, prostitution, work in restaurants, bars or domestic service. Girls who try to escape receive severe punishment that will almost certainly stop them and others from trying to run again. Human trafficking largely originates in the world's poorest countries. I ask you to help me stop this evil right now at the very root. The world is dealing with this problem on the surface, but we deal with it at the rood. People in Cambodia need Jesus. Only Jesus can set them free from bondage. Children need good education and a place were they can grow in a positive atmosphere.

Mission in Action is supporting 100 indigenous missionaries who reach the unreached with the Gospel. These missionaries are doing awesome work in rural areas. Some of them do the Lord's work in hostile regions, where their lives are in danger. But despite persecution and hardship they dedicate their lives to the ministry for the Lord. In India there is a growing silent number of Muslims who secretly have converted to Christianity. The new believers regularly meet in private homes to study the Bible and to pray. They are continually growing in the knowledge and understanding of the Bible. With your help we bringing light to a dark world.



Wherever I go in India, I hear testimonies and awesome reports from people, of changed lives and how they have been blessed through this mission's outreach. People's basic needs are met with safe water, better health, work opportunities, education, and most importantly, coming to know the saving knowledge of Jesus.

Children are a Blessing From the Lord

In many parts of India, especially in remote and rural areas, expectant parents hope for male children, based on the foolish idea that there is a greater benefit to have a male child and greater burden to have a female child. This idea is deeply embedded in the minds of mostly illiterate families. Millions of daughters are killed before they are born.



Mission in Action stops the widespread practice of aborting female fetuses by offering regular financial support to the families to help them raise their daughters. We were so happy to see a few of the beautiful girls that were saved from premature death. Today the parents are happy, and they are thankful that we intervened to save their daughter's lives. We can continue save lives and with your help we can put an end to this brutality. Someone have to speak and act in behalf of the unborn.

Note from Destiny

In India many kids do not have families, no one to take care of them or to watch over them. Many kids live on the streets with no clothes and hungry, children with no families and unable to take care of themselves. Mission in Action provides these children with a home. We give all the children three meals a day, provide clothes and great education. They learn the Bible and pray every day. The children have hope, and I saw Jesus in their eyes. I enjoyed playing games and drawing pictures with them. These children are very smart. It's cool!



Great Harvest in Vietnam

Christianity is a sensitive subject in Vietnam. The Government and the people still have in their mind the long, drawn-out war that ended in 1975. Most of the Vietnamese think Christianity is a western religion, and they distance themselves from Christians. Yet in spite of great opposition and persecution there is a great harvest of souls brought into the Kingdom of God. I preached the Gospel to thousands, and many received Jesus.
